A Bristol based charity working with young people from deprived areas in becoming useful, caring and responsible members of society. They raised funds to cover ongoing administrative costs as they had experienced a 400% increase in demand over the previous year.

The TFN grant was received at a crucial time as BREAD were halfway through their financial year and had a £8,000 deficit. The grant allowed Susan Moores, the manager, to focus on long term fund raising and she had significant successes. The most notable being £30,000 secured from the Henry Smith Charity and an increased core grant of £30,000 from the council. BREAD have continued to achieve results with their social education work including; an educational trip to South Africa for 9 young men and a comprehensive policy pack for their organisation.
